2013 Activities

The purpose of the Children Immunization Foundation (CIF), parent organization DC Immunization Welfare Center (DCIWC), provides vaccinations such as hepatitis “B”, measles, mumps and rubella (MMR), diphtheria, polio, tetanus (DPT), and whooping cough, through organized events to poor and needy children free of cost who cannot otherwise afford them. *CIF has initiated activities in the state of Bihar and Utter Pradesh (UP), India, where children rarely receive immunization due to poor economic conditions and lack of education. According to the Times of India, New Delhi, dated December 5, 2010, 90 % of Delhi population is not yet vaccinated against hepatitis “B”. Parents in poorer areas of India have no knowledge about importance of immunization. According to the Washington Post 57% of women in India give birth at home attended by untrained health care providers and more than half of the population make less than \$ 2.00 a day. Hepatitis B is a major public health problem in India; this life-threatening crisis will continue until vaccination programs and other control measures are established. The average estimated carrier rate of hepatitis B virus (HBV) in India is 4 percent with a total pool of approximately 36 million carriers. Social, economic, and health factors in different regions contribute to variations in carrier rates from one part of the country to another. Most of India's carrier pool is established in early childhood, predominantly by horizontal spread due to crowded living conditions and poor hygiene. In India, 240000 deaths annually occur due to complications from Hepatitis “B.” CIF’s goal is to provide vaccinations for poor and needy children, and awareness about importance of vaccines. CIF has provided vaccinations children of twelve schools in located in state of Bihar and Utter Pradesh. List is provided below and also posted on our website.*

CIF started in November 2003 and provided only 145 vaccinations. As of today, CIF has provided more than 10000 vaccinations to poor children. CIF is operated from USA and donations received are sent to Buxar, Bihar, India from where local operations are conducted.
