

Description of Required Schedule of Services or Benefits in 2006:

The purpose of the DC Immunization Welfare Center (DCIWC) is to provide vaccination such as measles, mumps and rubella (MMR), diphtheria, polio, tetanus (DPT), whooping cough, and hepatitis B, through organized events to poor and needy children free of cost who cannot otherwise afford them. *DCIWC has initiated activities in the state of Bihar, India, where children rarely receive immunization due to poor economic conditions and lack of education. Parents in poorer areas of India have no knowledge of immunization.* According to *the Washington Post* 57% of women in India give birth at home attended by untrained health care providers. It is very hard to think about immunizing those children who took birth by untrained health care providers. DCIWC's goal is to reach out to those parents and provide needy children the necessary immunizations.

DCIWC started providing vaccination to poor and needy children in India in November 2003. DCIWC is operated from the USA and all donations received in the USA are sent to Buxar, Bihar, India. DCIWC provided 145 vaccinations in 2003, 545 in 2004, 620 in 2005 and 550 in 2006. From November 2003 to November 2006, DCIWC has provided 1815 vaccinations. The following table describes the real services/benefits provided in calendar year 2006 by the DCIWC:
