Description of Required Schedule of Services or Benefits:

The purpose of the Children Immunization Foundation (CIF) also known as DC Immunization Welfare Center (DCIWC) is to provide vaccination such as hepatitis "B", measles, mumps and rubella (MMR), diphtheria, polio, tetanus (DPT), and whooping cough, through organized events to poor and needy children free of cost who cannot otherwise afford them. CIF has initiated activities in the state of Bihar, India, where children rarely receive immunization due to poor economic conditions and lack of education. Parents in poorer areas of India have no knowledge of immunization. According to the Washington Post 57% of women in India give birth at home attended by untrained health care providers and more than half of the population make less than \$ 2.00 a day. It is very hard to think about immunizing those children who took birth by untrained health care providers. CIF's goal is to provide vaccinations for poor and needy children, and awareness about importance of immunization. Since November 2007, CIF has provided vaccinations children of St. Mary School located at Buxar, Bal Vikas Kendra located at Hitan Pandari and Shree Ram Janki Saraswati Vidya Niketan Asharam Naya Bazar. Three schools have about more than 1700 poor students. CIF is providing Hepatitis "B" vaccines to all children at these schools.

CIF started providing vaccination to poor and needy children in India in November 2003. CIF is operated from the USA and all donations received in the USA are sent to Buxar, Bihar, India. CIF has provided 145 vaccinations in 2003, 545 in 2004, 620 in 2005, 550 in 2006, 729 in 2007, 1112 in 2008 and 913 in 2009. From November 2003 to December 2009, CIF has provided 4614 vaccinations. The following table describes the real services/benefits provided in calendar year 2010 by the CIF:
