Description of Required Schedule of Services or Benefits:

The purpose of the Children Immunization Foundation (CIF), under DC Immunization Welfare Center (DCIWC), is to provide vaccination such as hepatitis "B", measles, mumps and rubella (MMR), diphtheria, polio, tetanus (DPT), and whooping cough, through organized events to poor and needy children free of cost who cannot otherwise afford them. CIF has initiated activities in the state of Bihar, India, where children rarely receive immunization due to poor economic conditions and lack of education. According to the Times of India, New Delhi, dated December 5, 2010, 90 % of Delhi population is not yet vaccinated against hepatitis "B". Parents in poorer areas of India have no knowledge of immunization. According to the Washington Post 57% of women in India give birth at home attended by untrained health care providers and more than half of the population make less than \$ 2.00 a day. It is very hard to think about immunizing those children who took birth by untrained health care providers. CIF's goal is to provide vaccinations for poor and needy children, and awareness about importance of immunization. Since 2007, CIF has provided vaccinations children of St. Mary School, Bal Vikas Kendra in Hitan Pandary village in Bihar, Shree Ram Janki Sarswati Vidya Niketan located in Naya Bazar, Bihar, Rising Children Academy School, Buxar and Saurya Sainik School Dumraon, and has committed to provide Hepatitis "B" vaccines to all children in these schools.

CIF started in November 2003 and provided only 145 vaccinations. Today, CIF is providing about 1000 vaccinations every year. CIF is operated from USA and all donations received are sent to Buxar, Bihar, India. The following table describes the real services/benefits provided in calendar year 2011 by the CIF:
